

Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

With the approval of the Scoutmaster, the *assistant senior patrol leader* is appointed by the senior patrol leader, serves as his assistant, and takes his place when the senior patrol leader is absent. Among his specific responsibilities are training and providing direction for the troop quartermaster, scribe, Order of the Arrow troop representative, historian, librarian, and instructors. During his tenure as assistant senior patrol leader, the Scout is not a member of a patrol. Large troops may have more than just one assistant senior patrol leader.
